

THE 7 TYPES OF REGULATIONS

Regulations typically require you to do 7 different things (not necessarily all at the same time).

PERMIT

- Get a license or a permit to do something.
- e.g. Restaurants need a license to sell liquor.

MATERIAL

- Limit use of, or don't use, a material e.g. Heroin, lead.

PRODUCTION

- Manufacture a certain way.

INSPECTION

- Get something inspected or tested and/or prove it complies.

LABEL

- Stick a label or warning on product and packaging.

FIX

- Fix it, clean it or pay for it to be fixed or cleaned

REPORT

- Disclose information to the public and/or the government.
